Frequently Asked Questions

I have a referral. What do I need to do next?

A referral places your family on the request list. If you are staying with us for the first time, we will contact you when we receive your referral. Each family must call the House **on the day they will be arriving** to be sure that we have a room available. If space is not available, we will refer you to a local hotel at a reduced rate.

When can I check in?

Our preferred check in time is 12pm-8pm. Late arrivals are possible, but need to be arranged and confirmed ahead of time with a staff member. Guests 18 years and older must present a photo ID at the time of check-in. Transplant apartments are handled separately.

Who can stay at the RMH?

Most rooms accommodate up to 3 people. We have a few rooms for 4-6 people. Immediate family members directly involved in the care of the patient or siblings are allowed to stay. Certified service animals are allowed to stay with a guest family. No other pets are allowed.

How much does it cost to stay at the RMH?

The nightly charge is \$25 for a standard room and \$45 for an apartment (reserved for transplant patients). Financial aid is available.

Is there transportation to and from the hospital?

Free public bus service runs between the House and UNC Hospitals Monday through Friday. UNC Hospitals provide a scheduled shuttle service on weekdays and weekday evenings. The shuttle also runs a few times during the day on Saturday and Sunday. The House does not provide transportation.

How does the RMH differ from a hotel?

The House is a community living setting. Eating is not allowed in bedrooms, but storage and refrigerator space is available to each guest family in the House kitchen area. Each individual guest family is responsible for keeping their own room clean every day. Guest families are welcome to come and go as they please, but the room must be utilized every day for sleeping. If you plan to leave for longer than 24 hours, you must check out of the room.
